Handprint Firebird Wings

What you will need:

- Page 3 of these activity pages
- Crayons or colored pencils
- Red, orange, and yellow paint (washable)
- Paper plates
- Your hands!

To Do:

1. Decorate the body of your firebird with crayons or colored pencils.
2. Pour a small amount of one paint color onto a paper plate.
3. Place your hand into the paint and move it around until your whole palm is covered.
4. Pick up your hand and place it on one side of your firebird to make the first layer of its wings. Repeat with your opposite hand on the other side. (Use your right hand for the left-side wing and your left hand for the right-side wing so that your fingers create the longer feathers on the top of a firebird's wings.)
5. Repeat steps 2-4 with different colors on new plates until you have a full set of colorful wings on your bird!
